#### Mission & Statement of Faith

#### Purpose:

 Our goal is to see young people experience God's love in practical and everyday ways, and to help them grow in healthy and meaningful relationships with God, family and friends.

#### Statement of faith:

- God: We believe in one God eternally existing as three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. He is the sole creator of all things, seen and unseen. He was and is Jehovah of the Old Testament, Jesus Christ of the New Testament and the living, life-changing and indwelling Spirit of God in our lives today.
- Jesus Christ: We believe that God himself, physically entered humanity and came to earth as man in the person of Jesus Christ. He was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin, lived a perfect and sinless life, was crucified and confirmed dead. He was literally raised from the dead and ascended to His former glory at the right hand of the Father.
- Holy Spirit: We believe that the ever-present, Holy Spirit of God dwells in the believer; God's temple. It is this necessary and divine presence that heals, regenerates and empowers us for righteousness.
- Mankind: We believe that all mankind, through the sin of Adam and Eve, have a fallen and sinful nature, therefore separated from a just and holy God, unworthy of his forgiveness and presence. Consequently, man stands short of God's glory and is in need of a savior, a redeemer and mediator between himself and God.
- Salvation: We believe that salvation and the eternal hope of man lie only in the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ. His gracious sacrifice was a vicarious atonement for our sins and is a free gift to all who believe and receive Him through faith.
- Bible: We believe that the Bible is God's revelation of Truth to humanity, and is the inspired, inerrant Word of God. These Holy Scriptures are the final authority in all matters of life and truth. Holy Scripture stands complete and finished.
